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## Management Discussion of Fund Performance

June 7, 2018

This Management Discussion of Fund Performance presents the portfolio management team's view on the significant factors and developments during the period ended March 31, 2018, that have affected the Fund's performance and outlook. If the Fund was established during the period, "period" represents the period from inception to the end of the fiscal period. For information on the Fund's longer-term performance, as applicable, please refer to the *Past Performance* section of the report. In this report, "Mackenzie" refers to Mackenzie Financial Corporation, the manager of the Fund. In addition, net asset value ("NAV") refers to the value of the Fund as calculated for transaction purposes, on which the discussion of Fund performance is based.

### Investment Objective and Strategies

The Fund seeks above-average capital growth by investing primarily in equities of Canadian energy and natural resource companies. The Fund generally invests in both small- and large-capitalization companies. It may hold up to 49% of its assets in foreign investments.

### Risk

The risks of the Fund remain as discussed in the Fund's Simplified Prospectus.

The Fund is suitable for long-term investors looking for a Canadian resource sector equity fund to hold as part of their portfolio, who can handle the volatility of stock and commodity markets, and who have a high tolerance for risk.

### Results of Operations

#### Investment Performance

The performance of the Fund's Series A, Quadrus Series and Series LB securities is discussed below. The performance of all series is shown in the *Past Performance* section of the report. Where series returns differ, it is primarily because different levels of fees and expenses were charged to each series, or because securities of a series were not issued and outstanding for the entire reporting period. Please refer to the *Fund Formation and Series Information* section of this report for the varying management and administration fees payable by each series.

During the year, the Fund's Series A securities returned -9.6%, and Quadrus Series and Series LB securities returned -9.7% (after deducting fees and expenses paid by the series). This compares with a return of 1.7% for the Fund's broad-based index, the S&P/TSX Composite Index, and a return of -3.3% for a blended index.\* All index and series returns are calculated on a total return basis in Canadian dollar terms. Investors cannot invest in the index without incurring fees, expenses and commissions, which are not reflected in the index returns.

\* The blended index is composed of a 38.5% weighting in the S&P/TSX Energy Index (returned -10.9%), a 31.5% weighting in the S&P/TSX Materials Index (returned -2.9%), a 16.5% weighting in the MSCI World Energy (Net) Index (returned 1.1%) and a 13.5% weighting in the MSCI World Materials (Net) Index (returned 11.3%).

Canadian equity markets were up slightly despite continued weak economic growth as measured by gross domestic product. Challenges included concerns about the renegotiation of the North American Free Trade Agreement and uncertainty regarding future policy rate increases by the Bank of Canada, which raised rates three times during the year.

Within the S&P/TSX Composite Index, health care, information technology and consumer discretionary were the strongest sectors, while energy, materials and utilities were the weakest.

Global equity markets advanced to record highs earlier in the year in response to accelerating synchronized global growth and low inflation. Market volatility remained low despite growing geopolitical tensions, specifically between the United States and North Korea, and a more aggressive tone from central banks around the world. However, market volatility returned in January as a result of concerns over global trade tensions, rising inflation and the removal of monetary stimulus.

As a result of continued and synchronized global growth in developed and emerging markets, commodity prices rose during the year. However, not all resource equity prices reflected the increasing prices of the underlying commodities. Although the West Texas Intermediate crude oil price ended the year higher, overall sentiment toward energy equities remained poor.

The Fund underperformed the broad-based index primarily because of its overweight exposure to the energy sector. Given the Fund's mandate, the return of the blended index is a more meaningful comparison.

The Fund underperformed the blended index primarily due to its overweight position and stock selection in the oil and gas exploration and production sub-industry. At a country level, stock selection in Canada and the United States detracted from performance.

Conversely, an overweight position in forest products stocks contributed to performance. At a country level, overweight exposure to the United States and underweight exposure to Canada contributed.

The Fund did not hedge its foreign currency exposure, which detracted from absolute performance primarily as the U.S. dollar depreciated relative to the Canadian dollar.

Over the year, portfolio activity and market effect resulted in increased exposure to the United States, while exposure to Canada declined and exposure to Jersey was eliminated. Exposure to the materials sector, specifically the chemicals industry, as well as to the energy equipment and services industry, increased. Exposure to the metals and mining industry decreased. Changes to the portfolio included the elimination of the position in Marathon Petroleum Corp.

### Net Assets

The Fund's NAV declined by 19.8% to \$675.1 million at March 31, 2018, from \$842.1 million at March 31, 2017. This change was composed primarily of \$61.1 million in net losses (after including dividend and interest income) from investment performance, after deducting fees and expenses, and \$106.0 million in net redemptions.

As a result of these investments, the Fund is subject to large transaction risk as discussed in the Prospectus. Mackenzie manages this risk to reduce the possibility of any adverse effect on the Fund or on its investors, through such processes as requiring advance notice of large redemptions. At March 31, 2018, Mackenzie had received no such notices.

## Fees and Expenses

The management expense ratio ("MER") for Series A of 2.48% during the year ended March 31, 2018, was unchanged from the MER for the year ended March 31, 2017. The MER for Quadrus Series of 2.66% during the year ended March 31, 2018, was slightly lower than the MER of 2.67% for the year ended March 31, 2017. The MER for Series LB of 2.65% during the year ended March 31, 2018, was slightly higher than the MER of 2.64% for the year ended March 31, 2017. The MERs (before and after waivers or absorptions, if any) for each series are presented in the *Financial Highlights* section of this report. The MER for Series J increased due to an increase in fund costs.

## Recent Developments

Global leading indicators continue to point toward solid economic growth, with a potential increase in capital expenditures. The portfolio management team believes the lack of inflation and of accelerating loan growth to date suggest the current economic expansion may continue. This should provide a strong backdrop for commodity demand at a time when supply remains constrained from years of reduced investment. In general, resource equities appear undervalued relative to their underlying commodities, especially in the energy sector. The team continues to monitor several key indicators for signs that the economic cycle could be reaching maturity, including increasing wage growth, accelerating inflation, peaking capital expenditures, peaking global home and auto sales, and yield curve inversion. Until some of these indicators appear, the team expects continued global growth, which would benefit resource equities.

Effective June 1, 2018, Series PWF securities were consolidated into Series F securities.

## Related Party Transactions

The following arrangements result in fees paid by the Fund to Mackenzie or to companies affiliated with the Fund.

## Management and Administration Services

For each applicable series, the Fund paid management fees and administration fees to Mackenzie at the annual rates specified under *Fund Formation and Series Information* in this report and as more fully described in the Prospectus. In return for the administration fees, Mackenzie pays all costs and expenses (other than certain specified fund costs) required to operate the Fund that are not otherwise included in management fees. See also *Management Fees*.

## Other Related Party Transactions

Investment funds managed by Mackenzie invest in Series R securities of the Fund on a prospectus-exempt basis in accordance with the investment objectives of those funds. Series S securities are also issued on a prospectus-exempt basis to London Life Insurance Company, The Great-West Life Assurance Company and The Canada Life Assurance Company (collectively, the "Related Insurance Companies"), all of which are companies affiliated with Mackenzie. At March 31, 2018, the Related Insurance Companies owned 64.5% of the Fund's NAV, and funds managed by Mackenzie owned 5.9% of the Fund's NAV. All related party transactions are based on the NAV per security on each transaction day.

The Fund did not rely on an approval, positive recommendation or standing instruction from the Mackenzie Funds' Independent Review Committee with respect to any related party transactions.

At March 31, 2018, Mackenzie had an investment of \$0.5 million in the Fund (0.1% of the Fund's NAV).

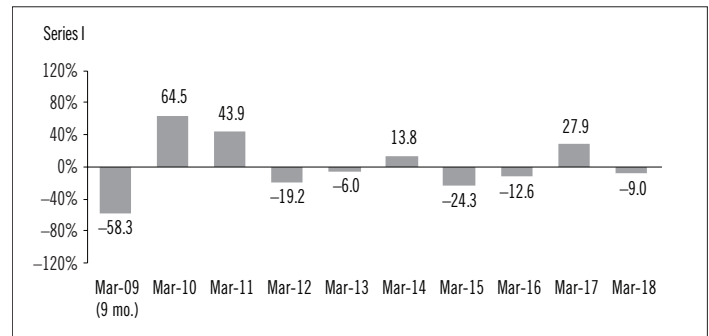
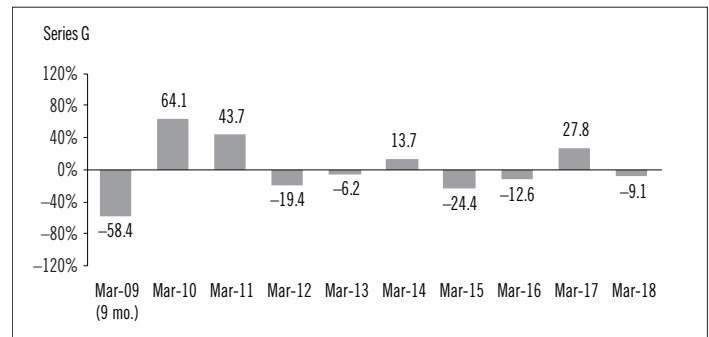
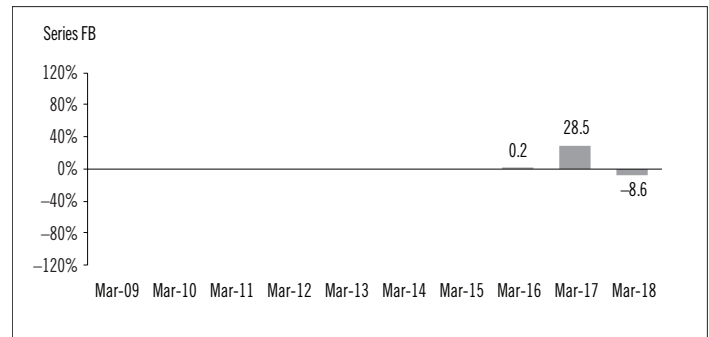
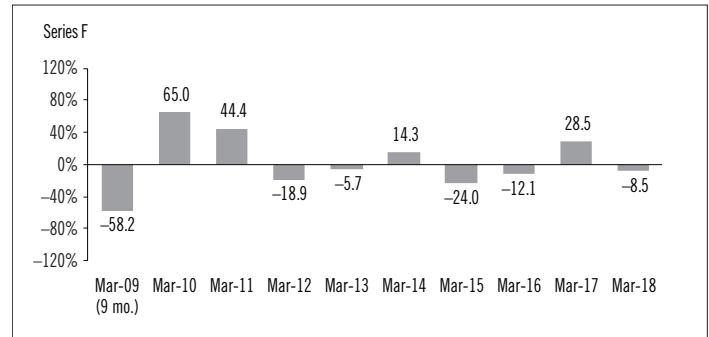
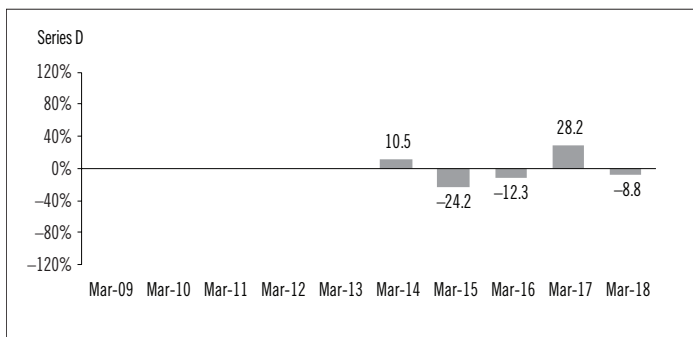
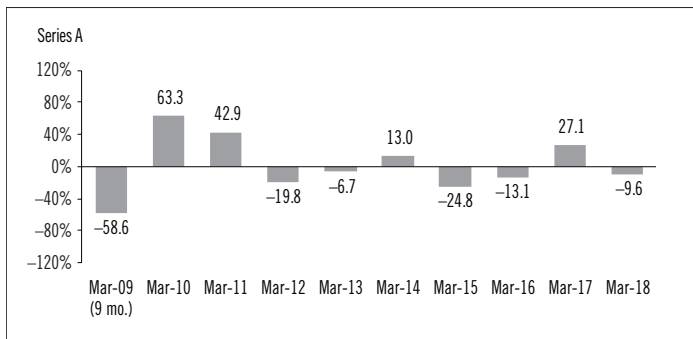
## Past Performance

The S&P/TSX Energy Index includes energy sector stocks within the S&P/TSX Composite Index. The stocks are selected based on the Global Industry Classification Standard ("GICS").

The S&P/TSX Materials Index includes materials sector stocks within the S&P/TSX Composite Index. The stocks are selected based on GICS.

The MSCI World Energy (Net) Index is designed to capture the large- and mid-cap segments across 23 developed market country indices. All securities in the index are classified in the energy sector as per GICS. Net total returns are after the deduction of withholding tax from the foreign income and dividends of its constituents.

The MSCI World Materials (Net) Index is designed to capture the large- and mid-cap segments across 23 developed market country indices. All securities in the index are classified in the materials sector as per GICS. Net total returns are after the deduction of withholding tax from the foreign income and dividends of its constituents.

The higher a fund's portfolio turnover rate in a period, the greater the trading costs payable by the fund in the period, and the greater the chance of an investor receiving taxable capital gains in the year. There is not necessarily a relationship between a high turnover rate and the performance of a fund. The portfolio turnover rate is not provided when the Fund is less than one year old. The value of any trades to realign the Fund's portfolio after a fund merger, if any, is excluded from the portfolio turnover rate.

## Management Fees

The management fee for each applicable series is calculated and accrued daily as a percentage of its NAV. The Fund's management fees were used by Mackenzie to pay for the costs of managing the investment portfolio of the Fund and/or the underlying fund(s), as applicable, including providing investment analysis and recommendations, making investment decisions, making brokerage arrangements for the purchase and sale of the investment portfolio, and providing other services. Mackenzie also used the management fees to fund sales commissions, trailing commissions and any other compensation (collectively "distribution-related payments") to registered dealers and brokers whose clients invest in the Fund.

LBC Financial Services Inc. ("LBC") is the principal distributor for the LBC series securities of the Fund (as listed under *Fund Formation and Series Information*) and receives a portion of the management fees that the Fund pays to Mackenzie. Under this arrangement, LBC was entitled to approximately 25% of the total management fees that Mackenzie received from the LBC series of all Mackenzie funds during the year. Mackenzie is responsible for paying all distribution-related payments to LBC-authorized dealers whose clients invest in the LBC series of the Fund.

Quadrus Investment Services Ltd. ("Quadrus"), an affiliate of Mackenzie, is the principal distributor for the Quadrus series securities of the Fund (as listed under *Fund Formation and Series Information*) and receives a portion of the management fees that the Fund pays to Mackenzie. Under this arrangement, Quadrus was entitled to approximately 79% of the total management fees that Mackenzie received from the Quadrus Group of Funds during the year. As the principal distributor of the Quadrus series securities of the Fund, Quadrus is responsible for paying certain administrative costs and all distribution-related payments to registered dealers whose clients invest in those securities of the Fund.

The following dealers affiliated with Mackenzie may be entitled to distribution-related payments from Mackenzie on the same basis as unrelated registered brokers and dealers: IPC Securities Corporation, Investors Group Securities Inc., IPC Investment Corporation and Investors Group Financial Services Inc.

Mackenzie used approximately 43% of the total management fee revenues received from all Mackenzie funds during the year to fund distribution-related payments to registered dealers and brokers. In comparison, such distribution-related payments for the Fund represented on average 38% of the management fees paid by all applicable series of the Fund during the year. The actual percentage for each series may be higher or lower than the average depending on the level of trailing commissions and sales commissions paid for that series.

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## Fund Formation and Series Information

The Fund may have undergone a number of changes, such as a reorganization or a change in manager, mandate or name. A history of the major changes affecting the Fund in the last 10 years can be found in the Fund's Annual Information Form.

The Fund may issue an unlimited number of securities of each series. The number of issued and outstanding securities of each series is disclosed in *Financial Highlights*.
