Management Discussion of Fund Performance

November 12, 2019

This Management Discussion of Fund Performance presents the portfolio management team's view on the significant factors and developments during the period ended September 30, 2019, that have affected the Fund's performance and outlook. If the Fund was established during the period, "period" represents the period from inception to the end of the fiscal period. For information on the Fund's longer-term performance, as applicable, please refer to the *Past Performance* section of the report. In this report, "Mackenzie" refers to Mackenzie Financial Corporation, the manager of the Fund. In addition, net asset value ("NAV") refers to the value of the Fund as calculated for transaction purposes, on which the discussion of Fund performance is based.

Risk

The risks of the Fund remain as discussed in the Fund's Simplified Prospectus.

The Fund is suitable for long-term investors looking for a Canadian equity fund to hold as part of their portfolio, who can handle the volatility of stock markets and who have a medium tolerance for risk. Before June 28, 2019, the Fund was deemed suitable for investors who had a medium to high tolerance for risk.

Results of Operations

Investment Performance

The performance of the Fund's Series A securities is discussed below. The performance of all series is shown in the *Past Performance* section of the report. Where series returns differ, it is primarily because different levels of fees and expenses were charged to each series, or because securities of a series were not issued and outstanding for the entire reporting period. Please refer to the *Fund Formation and Series Information* section of this report for the varying management and administration fees payable by each series.

During the period, the Fund's Series A securities returned 2.4% (after deducting fees and expenses paid by the series). This compares with a return of 5.1% for the Fund's broad-based index, the S&P/TSX Composite Index, and a return of -1.5% for the Fund's narrow index, the S&P/TSX SmallCap Index. All index and series returns are calculated on a total return basis in Canadian dollar terms. Investors cannot invest in an index without incurring fees, expenses and commissions, which are not reflected in the index returns.

Despite volatility, Canadian equity markets ended the period higher. Oil prices ended lower in response to slowing global economic growth. The Bank of Canada kept its policy interest rate unchanged. Policymakers stated that the degree of monetary policy accommodation was appropriate given that the economy was operating close to potential and inflation was on target.

Canadian small-cap stocks generally underperformed larger-cap stocks. Within the S&P/TSX SmallCap Index, financials, consumer discretionary and materials were the strongest sectors, while energy, health care and information technology were the weakest.

The Fund underperformed the broad-based index because of its allocation to small-cap stocks. Stock selection in the consumer discretionary sector detracted from performance relative to both the broad-based index and the narrow index, while underweight positions in health care and energy contributed. Given the Fund's mandate, the return of the narrow index is a more meaningful comparison.

The Fund outperformed the narrow index, with stock selection in the energy sector contributing to performance. Conversely, underweight exposure to the materials sector detracted from performance.

Over the period, portfolio activity and market effect resulted in increased exposure to the industrials and consumer discretionary sectors, and decreased exposure to energy.

Net Assets

The Fund's NAV declined by 4.0% to \$136.3 million at September 30, 2019, from \$141.9 million at March 31, 2019. This change was composed primarily of \$4.1 million in net income (including dividend and interest income) from investment performance, after deducting fees and expenses, and \$9.7 million in net redemptions.

See *Other Related Party Transactions* for the percentage of the Fund's NAV owned by related parties. As a result of these investments, the Fund is subject to large transaction risk as discussed in the Prospectus. Mackenzie manages this risk to reduce the possibility of any adverse effect on the Fund or on its investors.

Fees and Expenses

The annualized management expense ratio ("MER") for Series A of 2.52% during the period ended September 30, 2019, was slightly lower than the MER of 2.54% for the year ended March 31, 2019. The MERs (before and after waivers or absorptions, if any) for all series are presented in the *Financial Highlights* section of this report. The MER for Series F decreased due to a decrease in the management and administration fee rates effective June 1, 2018, as noted in the *Fund Formation and Series Information* section of the report.



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Recent Developments

The portfolio management team believes that companies with strong balance sheets and solid business fundamentals are poised to perform well despite currently fragile investor confidence. Disappointing manufacturing data in the Purchasing Managers Index indicates that global economic growth continues to slow. In the team's opinion, this weakness is largely driven by prolonged trade tensions. The damage so far has been limited to industry and manufacturing, while consumer spending remains strong, especially in e-commerce. The team expects the next months to bring greater clarity on issues such as the relation of the United Kingdom to the European Union and the progress of U.S.–China trade talks, along with further economic data from both countries.

Related Party Transactions

The following arrangements result in fees paid by the Fund to Mackenzie or to companies affiliated with the Fund.

Management and Administration Services

For each applicable series, the Fund paid management fees and administration fees to Mackenzie at the annual rates specified under *Fund Formation and Series Information* in this report and as more fully described in the Prospectus. In return for the administration fees, Mackenzie pays all costs and expenses (other than certain specified fund costs) required to operate the Fund that are not included in management fees. Operating expenses attributable to B-Series are charged directly to that particular series. See also *Management Fees*.

Other Related Party Transactions

Investment funds managed by Mackenzie invest in Series R securities of the Fund on a prospectus-exempt basis in accordance with the investment objectives of those funds. At September 30, 2019, funds managed by Mackenzie owned 19.8% of the Fund's NAV. All related party transactions are based on the NAV per security on each transaction day.

At September 30, 2019, Mackenzie had an investment of \$9,508 in the Fund (less than 0.1% of the Fund's NAV).

The Fund did not rely on an approval, positive recommendation or standing instruction from the Mackenzie Funds' Independent Review Committee with respect to any related party transactions.



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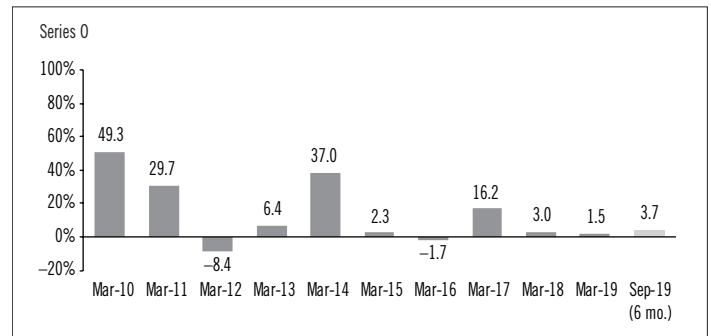
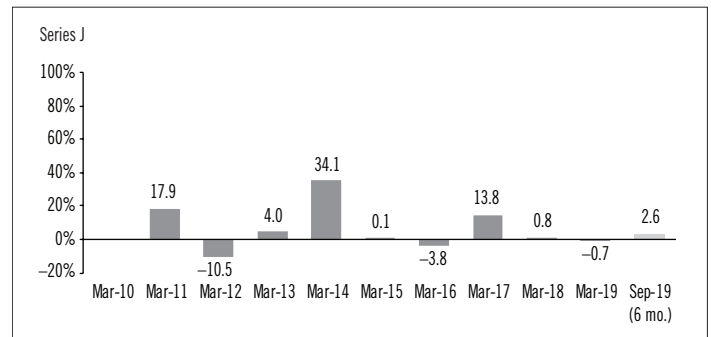
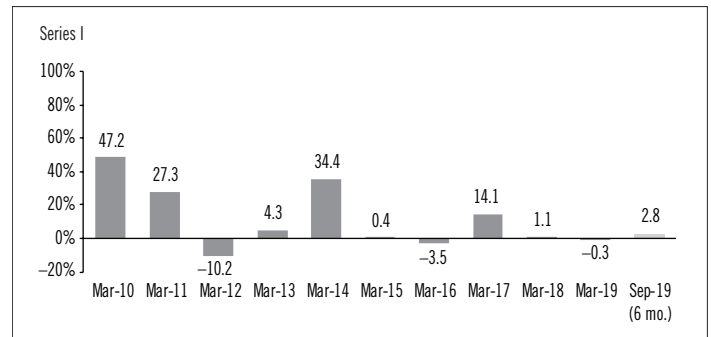
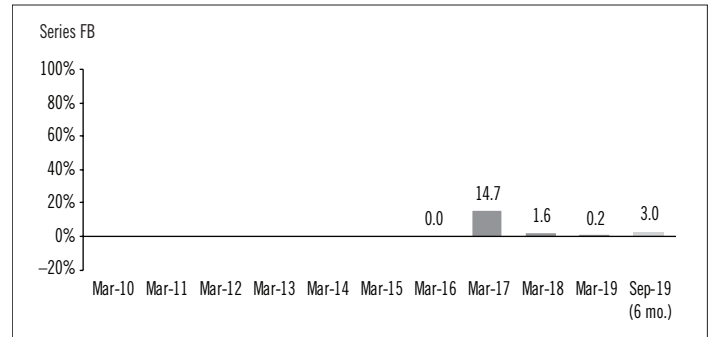
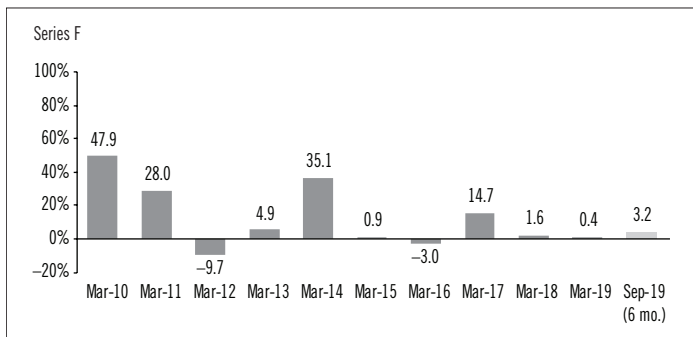
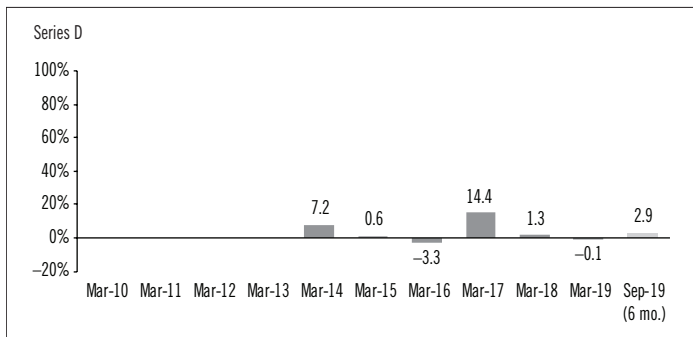
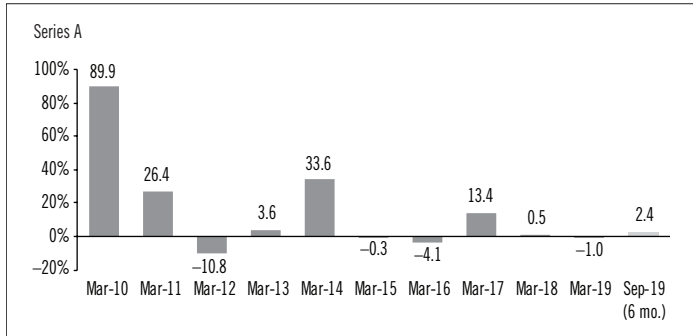

Management Fees

The management fee for each applicable series is calculated and accrued daily as a percentage of its NAV. The Fund's management fees were used by Mackenzie to pay for the costs of managing the investment portfolio of the Fund and/or the underlying fund(s), as applicable, including providing investment analysis and recommendations, making investment decisions, making brokerage arrangements for the purchase and sale of the investment portfolio, and providing other services. Mackenzie also used the management fees to fund sales commissions, trailing commissions and any other compensation (collectively "distribution-related payments") to registered dealers and brokers whose clients invest in the Fund.

The following dealers affiliated with Mackenzie may be entitled to distribution-related payments from Mackenzie on the same basis as unrelated registered brokers and dealers: IPC Securities Corporation, Investors Group Securities Inc., IPC Investment Corporation and Investors Group Financial Services Inc.

Mackenzie used approximately 43% of the total management fee revenues received from all Mackenzie funds during the period to fund distribution-related payments to registered dealers and brokers. In comparison, such distribution-related payments for the Fund represented on average 32% of the management fees paid by all applicable series of the Fund during the period. The actual percentage for each series may be higher or lower than the average depending on the level of trailing commissions and sales commissions paid for that series.



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Fund Formation and Series Information

The Fund may have undergone a number of changes, such as a reorganization or a change in manager, mandate or name. A history of the major changes affecting the Fund in the last 10 years can be found in the Fund's Annual Information Form.

Date of Formation December 10, 1985

The Fund may issue an unlimited number of securities of each series. The number of issued and outstanding securities of each series is disclosed in Financial Highlights.

Series A securities are offered to retail investors investing a minimum of \$500. Before September 25, 2009, Series A securities were known as Advisor Series.

Series D securities are offered to retail investors investing a minimum of \$500 through a discount brokerage or other account approved by Mackenzie.

Series F securities are offered to investors who are enrolled in a dealer-sponsored fee-for-service or wrap program, who are subject to an asset-based fee rather than commissions on each transaction and who invest at least \$500; they are also available to employees of Mackenzie and its subsidiaries, and directors of Mackenzie.

Series FB securities are offered to retail investors investing a minimum of \$500. Investors are required to negotiate their advisor service fee, which cannot exceed 1.50%, with their financial advisor.

Series O securities are offered only to investors investing a minimum of \$500,000 who are enrolled in Mackenzie Portfolio Architecture Service or Open Architecture Service; certain institutional investors; investors in a qualified group plan, and certain qualifying employees of Mackenzie and its subsidiaries.

Series PW securities are offered through our Private Wealth Solutions to certain high net worth investors who invest a minimum of \$100,000.

Series PWFB securities are offered through our Private Wealth Solutions to certain high net worth investors who invest a minimum of \$100,000. Investors are required to negotiate their advisor service fee, which cannot exceed 1.50%, with their financial advisor.

Series PWX securities are offered through our Private Wealth Solutions to certain high net worth investors who invest a minimum of \$100,000. Investors are required to negotiate their advisor service fee, which cannot exceed 1.50%, with their financial advisor.

Series R securities are offered only to other affiliated funds and certain institutional investors in connection with fund-of-fund arrangements.

Series I, Series J and B-Series securities are no longer available for sale.

Series PWF securities are no longer available for sale. Effective June 1, 2018, Series PWF securities were consolidated into Series F securities.

Investor Series securities are no longer available for sale, except for additional purchases by investors who have held these securities since December 11, 2017.

An investor in the Fund may choose among different purchase options that are available under each series. These purchase options are a sales charge purchase option, a redemption charge purchase option and various low-load purchase options. The charges under the sales charge purchase option are negotiated by investors with their dealers. The charges under the redemption charge and low-load purchase options are paid to Mackenzie if an investor redeems securities of the Fund during specific periods. Not all purchase options are available under each series of the Fund, and the charges for each purchase option may vary among the different series. For further details on these purchase options, please refer to the Fund's Simplified Prospectus and Fund Facts.
