Management Discussion of Fund Performance

November 11, 2022

This Management Discussion of Fund Performance presents the portfolio management team's view on the significant factors and developments that have affected the Fund's performance and outlook in the six-month period ended September 30, 2022 (the "period"). If the Fund was established during the period, "period" represents the period since inception.

In this report, "Mackenzie" and "the Manager" refer to Mackenzie Financial Corporation, the manager of the Fund. In addition, net asset value ("NAV") refers to the value of the Fund as calculated for transaction purposes, on which the discussion of Fund performance is based.

Results of Operations

Investment Performance

The performance of all series in the current and previous periods is shown in the *Past Performance* section of the report. Performance will vary by series primarily because fees and expenses differ between series, or because securities of a series were not issued and outstanding for the entire reporting period. Please refer to the *Fund Formation and Series Information* section of this report for the varying management and administration fees payable by each series. The following comparison to market indices is intended to help investors understand the Fund's performance relative to the general performance of the markets. However, the Fund's mandate may be different from that of the indices shown.

During the period, the Fund's Series A securities returned -12.3% (after deducting fees and expenses paid by the series). This compares with a return of -13.0% for the Fund's broad-based index, the MSCI World (Net) Index, and a return of -11.9% for the Fund's narrow index, the TOBAM Maximum Diversification All World Developed Index. All index and series returns are calculated on a total return basis in Canadian dollar terms. Investors cannot invest in an index without incurring fees, expenses and commissions, which are not reflected in the index returns.

A stronger U.S. dollar and high inflation contributed to economic weakness across many global economies over the period. European economies also faced energy supply concerns and an increasing cost of living, while China's growth slowed in response to its ongoing "zero COVID-19" policy. The U.S. economy was relatively stronger but also showed signs of slowing. Moderating economic indicators and expectations of higher interest rates put downward pressure on equity markets.

Within the MSCI World (Net) Index, Portugal, Finland and Hong Kong were the strongest-performing markets in Canadian dollar terms, while Austria, Germany and Sweden were the weakest. The energy, consumer staples and health care sectors were the strongest performers, while communication services, information technology and materials were the weakest.

The Fund invested all its assets in Mackenzie Maximum Diversification All World Developed Index ETF (the "Underlying ETF"), which tracks the narrow index. The Underlying ETF's core investment philosophy is to seek enhanced diversification through a balanced exposure to all relevant risk factors in the global developed country equity markets. As a result of this approach, the Fund may have less concentrated risk exposures than those of a market capitalization weighted index, such as the broad-based index.

The Fund outperformed the broad-based index, with the Underlying ETF's stock selection in the United States and overweight position and stock selection in Japan contributing to performance. In sector terms, underweight exposure to information technology and overweight exposure to health care contributed to performance.

Conversely, stock selection in the United Kingdom detracted from performance relative to the broad-based index. In sector terms, overweight exposure to communication services and stock selection in materials detracted from performance.

The difference in performance between the Fund and the narrow index resulted primarily from management fees and other operating expenses. Their impact was partially offset by income from securities lending and a minor cash position in the Underlying ETF as equity markets declined. In addition, the Underlying ETF traded at a premium to its net asset value, and that premium increased over the period.

Over the period, changes were made to the Underlying ETF's holdings to reflect changes in the composition of the narrow index.

Net Assets

The Fund's net assets decreased by 20.8% during the period to \$30.0 million. This change was composed primarily of \$4.4 million in net losses (including any interest and/or dividend income) from investment performance, after deducting fees and expenses, and a decrease of \$3.5 million due to net securityholder activity (including sales, redemptions and cash distributions).

Fees and Expenses

The annualized management expense ratio ("MER") for each series during the period ended September 30, 2022, was generally similar to the MER for the year ended March 31, 2022. Total expenses paid vary from period to period mainly as a result of changes in average assets in each series. The MER for Series D decreased due to a decrease in the management fee rate effective April 4, 2022, as noted in the *Fund Formation and Series Information* section of the report. The MERs for all series are presented in the *Financial Highlights* section of this report.

Recent Developments

Because the Underlying ETF is an index fund, neither market expectations nor recent developments affect the composition of the Fund's portfolio.

Related Party Transactions

Management and Administration Services

For each applicable series, the Fund paid management fees and administration fees to the Manager at the annual rates specified under *Fund Formation and Series Information* in this report and as more fully described in the Prospectus. In return for the administration fees, the Manager pays all costs and expenses (other than certain specified fund costs) required to operate the Fund that are not included in management fees. See also *Management Fees*.

Other Related Party Transactions

At September 30, 2022, Mackenzie had an investment of \$0.04 million in the Fund (0.1% of the Fund's NAV).

During the period, the Fund received \$0.1 million in income distributions from investments in exchange-traded funds ("ETFs") managed by Mackenzie to offset fees paid within those ETFs. There is no assurance that these distributions will continue in the future.

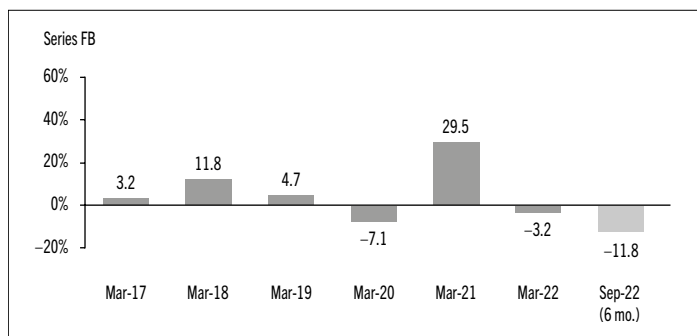
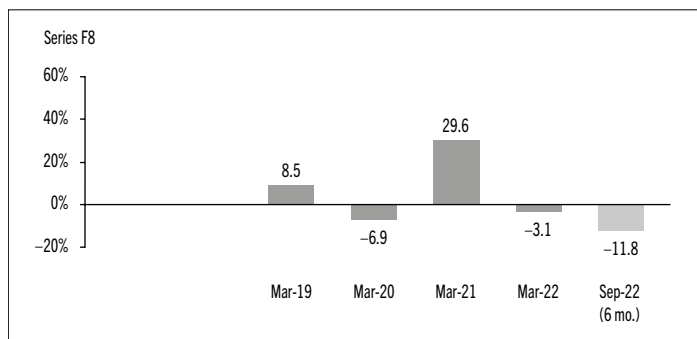
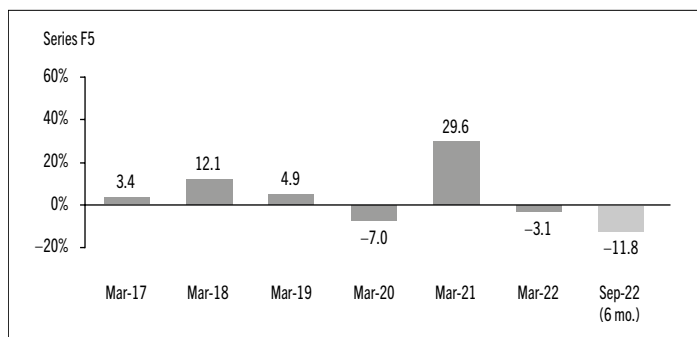
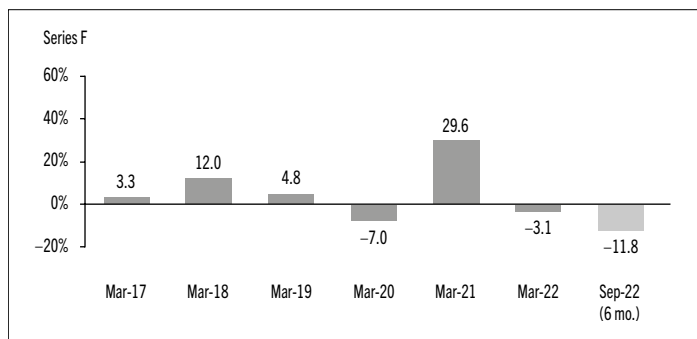
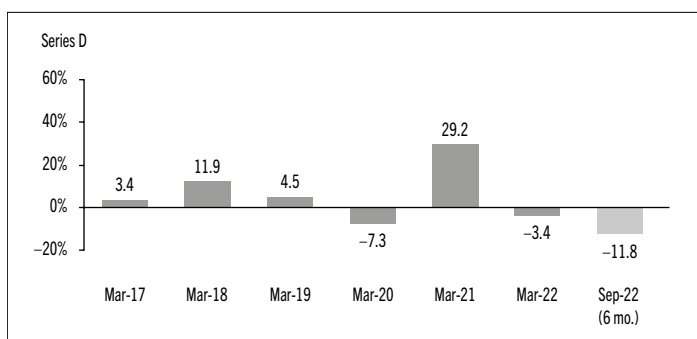
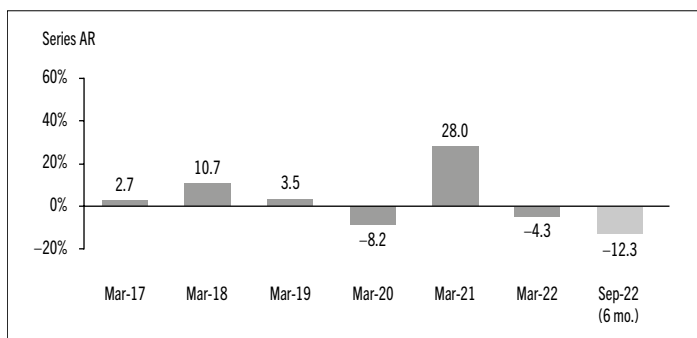
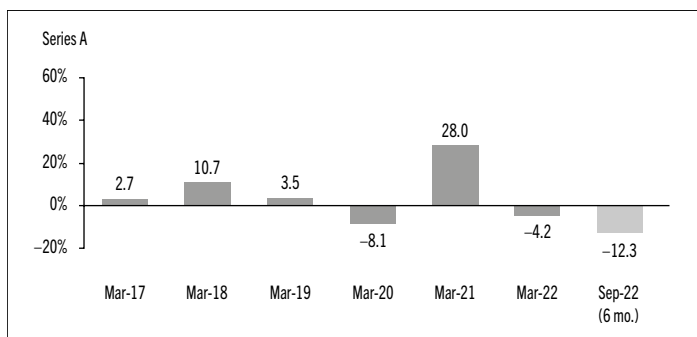
The Fund did not rely on an approval, positive recommendation or standing instruction from the Mackenzie Funds' Independent Review Committee with respect to any related party transactions in the period.

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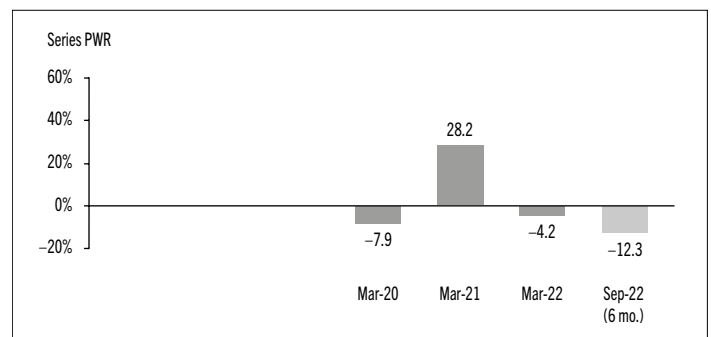
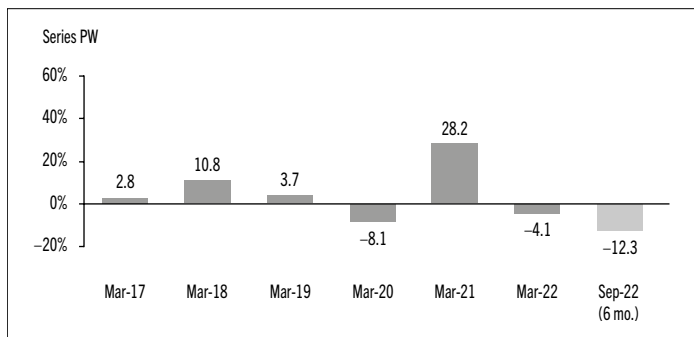
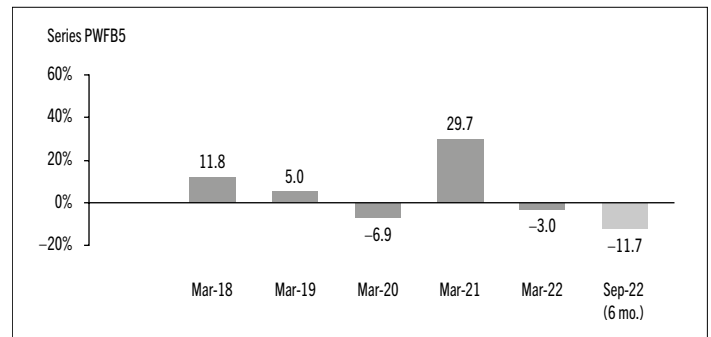
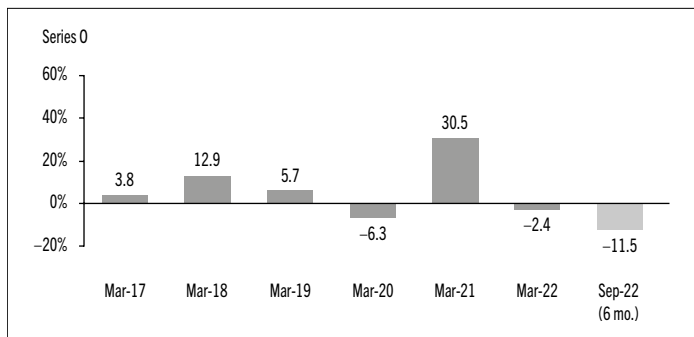
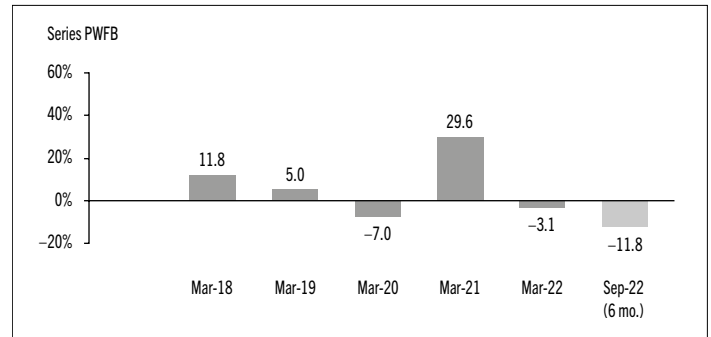
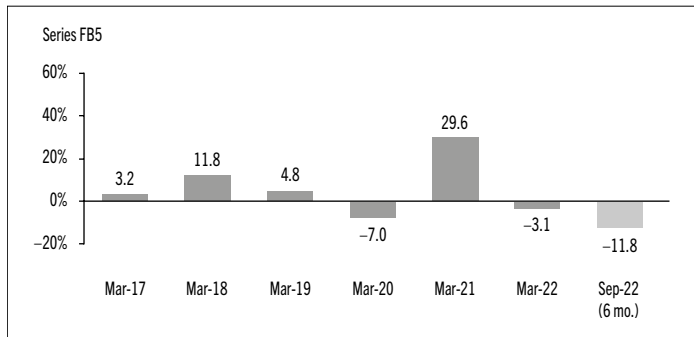
Past Performance

Management Fees

The management fee for each applicable series is calculated and accrued daily as a percentage of its NAV. The Fund's management fees were used by the Manager to pay for the costs of managing the investment portfolio of the Fund and/or the underlying fund(s), as applicable, including providing investment analysis and recommendations, making investment decisions, making brokerage arrangements for the purchase and sale of the investment portfolio, and providing other services. The Manager also used the management fees to fund sales commissions, trailing commissions and any other compensation (collectively "distribution-related payments") to registered dealers and brokers whose clients invest in the Fund.

The following dealers affiliated with the Manager may be entitled to distribution-related payments from the Manager on the same basis as unrelated registered brokers and dealers: IPC Securities Corporation, Investors Group Securities Inc., IPC Investment Corporation and Investors Group Financial Services Inc.

The Manager used approximately 42% of the total management fee revenues received from all Mackenzie funds during the period to fund distribution-related payments to registered dealers and brokers. In comparison, such distribution-related payments for the Fund represented on average 46% of the management fees paid by all applicable series of the Fund during the period. The actual percentage for each series may be higher or lower than the average depending on the level of trailing commissions and sales commissions paid for that series. The higher proportion of distribution-related payments is primarily attributable to sales commissions related to gross sales of redemption charge securities of the Fund.
