Management Discussion of Fund Performance

November 12, 2019

This Management Discussion of Fund Performance presents the portfolio management team's view on the significant factors and developments during the period ended September 30, 2019, that have affected the Fund's performance and outlook. If the Fund was established during the period, "period" represents the period from inception to the end of the fiscal period. For information on the Fund's longer-term performance, as applicable, please refer to the *Past Performance* section of the report. In this report, "Mackenzie" refers to Mackenzie Financial Corporation, the manager of the Fund. In addition, net asset value ("NAV") refers to the value of the Fund as calculated for transaction purposes, on which the discussion of Fund performance is based.

Risk

The risks of the Fund remain as discussed in the Fund's Simplified Prospectus.

The Fund is suitable for medium- to long-term investors looking for a U.S. equity fund to hold as part of their portfolio, who can handle the volatility of stock markets and who have a low to medium tolerance for risk. Before June 28, 2019, the Fund was deemed suitable for investors who had a medium tolerance for risk. The Fund may not be held within a registered plan.

Results of Operations

Investment Performance

The performance of the Fund's Series PW and Series LW securities is discussed below. The performance of all series is shown in the *Past Performance* section of the report. Where series returns differ, it is primarily because different levels of fees and expenses were charged to each series, or because securities of a series were not issued and outstanding for the entire reporting period. Please refer to the *Fund Formation and Series Information* section of this report for the varying management and administration fees payable by each series.

During the period, the Fund's Series PW securities returned 4.7%, and Series LW securities returned 4.9% (after deducting fees and expenses paid by the series). This compares with the S&P 500 Index return of 5.1%. All index and series returns are calculated on a total return basis in Canadian dollar terms. Investors cannot invest in an index without incurring fees, expenses and commissions, which are not reflected in the index returns.

U.S. bond yields moved materially lower over the period, while equity markets rose. The U.S. economy continued its record expansion, although earnings growth flattened to near zero. The U.S. Federal Reserve decreased the federal funds rate twice, by 25 basis points each time, after global growth slowed and trade tensions worsened. Full employment and moderate gross domestic product growth were offset by weaker business investment, slowing manufacturing and uncertainty regarding ongoing trade negotiations between the United States and China.

Within the S&P 500 Index, utilities, real estate and financials were the strongest sectors in Canadian dollar terms, while energy, health care and industrials were the weakest.

The Fund currently invests all its assets in Mackenzie Private US Equity Pool (the "Underlying Fund"). The following discussion reflects the Underlying Fund's allocation decisions and the activities and performance of its underlying investment funds and other directly held securities. The Fund underperformed the index, with stock selection in the information technology, consumer discretionary and communication services sectors detracting from performance.

Conversely, stock selection in the health care sector, as well as an underweight position in the energy sector, contributed to performance.

The Fund's foreign currency exposure is actively managed to help mitigate risk and take advantage of opportunities at the total portfolio level. During the period, currency activities contributed to performance.

Over the period, portfolio activity and market effect resulted in new exposure to Switzerland and Germany, while exposure to the United States and the Netherlands decreased. At the sector level, exposure to information technology, communication services and financials increased, while exposure to health care, energy and consumer discretionary decreased.

Net Assets

The Fund's NAV increased by 24.1% to \$3.1 million at September 30, 2019, from \$2.5 million at March 31, 2019. This change was composed primarily of \$0.1 million in net income from investment performance, after deducting fees and expenses, and \$0.5 million in net sales.

At September 30, 2019, 18.9% of the Fund's NAV was held by investors that individually owned 10% or more of the Fund. As a result of these investments, the Fund is subject to large transaction risk as discussed in the Prospectus. Mackenzie manages this risk to reduce the possibility of any adverse effect on the Fund or on its investors, through such processes as requiring advance notice of large redemptions. At September 30, 2019, Mackenzie had received no such notices.

Fees and Expenses

The annualized management expense ratio ("MER") for Series PW of 2.20% during the period ended September 30, 2019, was slightly lower than the MER of 2.21% for the year ended March 31, 2019. The annualized MER for Series LW of 2.16% during the period ended September 30, 2019, was slightly higher than the annualized MER of 2.15% for the period ended March 31, 2019. The MERs (before and after waivers or absorptions, if any) for all series are presented in the *Financial Highlights* section of this report. The MER for Series PWF5 decreased due to a decrease in fund costs and a decrease in the management fee rate effective June 1, 2018, as noted in the *Fund Formation and Series Information* section of the report.



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Recent Developments

On July 19, 2019, Nelson Arruda of the Mackenzie Multi-Asset Strategies team assumed responsibility from Alain Bergeron for the asset mix of the Fund and the Underlying Fund.

In the United States, growth has slowed largely due to weaker trade and manufacturing. However, other significant but more domestically focused elements of the U.S. economy, such as personal consumption and housing, have not weakened. In addition, the Federal Reserve started an easing cycle in response to slowing global growth and concerns about persistently low inflation. The Multi-Asset Strategies team believes that although U.S. manufacturing has contracted slightly, consumers and the housing sector may buffer this negative trend, allowing the U.S. economy to avoid recession.

Related Party Transactions

The following arrangements result in fees paid by the Fund to Mackenzie or to companies affiliated with the Fund.

Management and Administration Services

For each applicable series, the Fund paid management fees and administration fees to Mackenzie at the annual rates specified under *Fund Formation and Series Information* in this report and as more fully described in the Prospectus. In return for the administration fees, Mackenzie pays all costs and expenses (other than certain specified fund costs) required to operate the Fund that are not included in management fees. See also *Management Fees*.

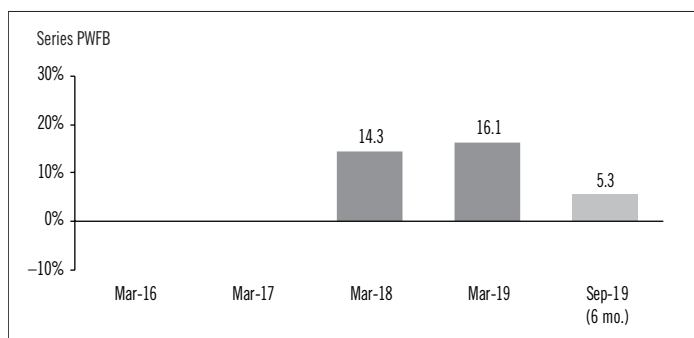
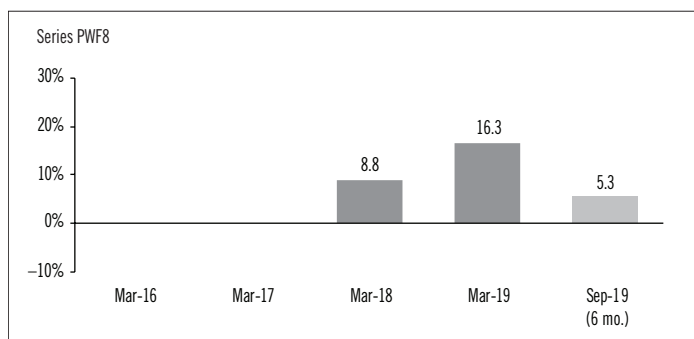
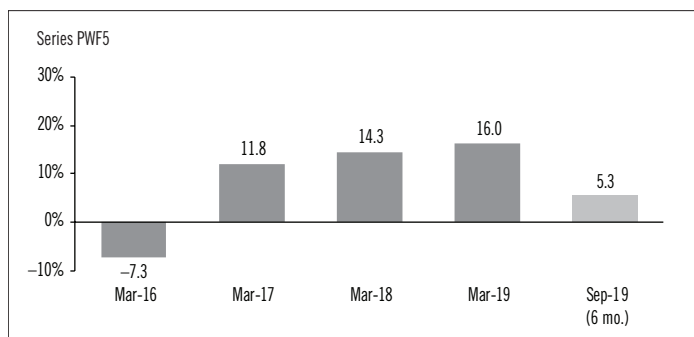
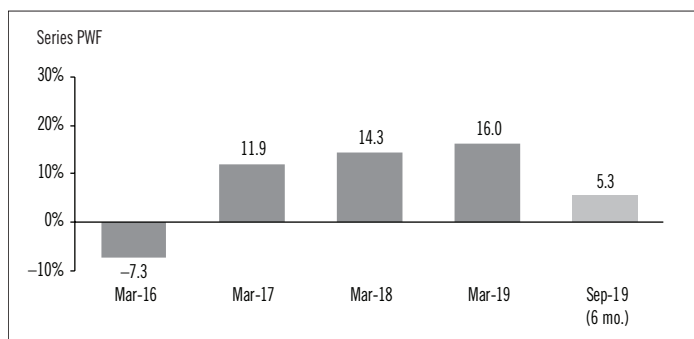
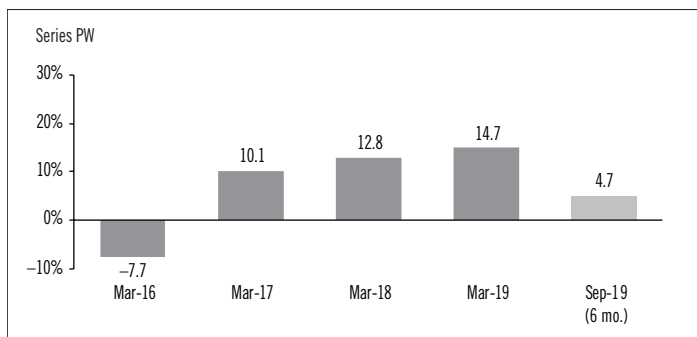
Other Related Party Transactions

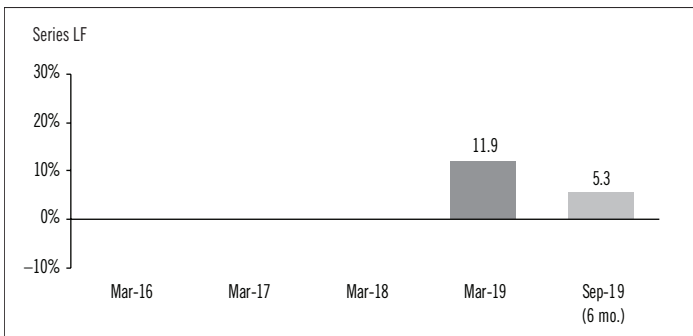

Management Fees

The management fee for each applicable series is calculated and accrued daily as a percentage of its NAV. The Fund's management fees were used by Mackenzie to pay for the costs of managing the investment portfolio of the Fund and/or the underlying fund(s), as applicable, including providing investment analysis and recommendations, making investment decisions, making brokerage arrangements for the purchase and sale of the investment portfolio, and providing other services. Mackenzie also used the management fees to fund sales commissions, trailing commissions and any other compensation (collectively "distribution-related payments") to registered dealers and brokers whose clients invest in the Fund.

LBC Financial Services Inc. ("LBC") is the principal distributor for the LBC series securities of the Fund (as listed under *Fund Formation and Series Information*) and receives a portion of the management fees that the Fund pays to Mackenzie. Under this arrangement, LBC was entitled to approximately 23% of the total management fees that Mackenzie received from the LBC series of all Mackenzie funds during the period. Mackenzie is responsible for paying all distribution-related payments to LBC-authorized dealers whose clients invest in the LBC series of the Fund.

The following dealers affiliated with Mackenzie may be entitled to distribution-related payments from Mackenzie on the same basis as unrelated registered brokers and dealers: IPC Securities Corporation, Investors Group Securities Inc., IPC Investment Corporation and Investors Group Financial Services Inc.

Mackenzie used approximately 43% of the total management fee revenues received from all Mackenzie funds during the period to fund distribution-related payments to registered dealers and brokers. In comparison, such distribution-related payments for the Fund represented on average 44% of the management fees paid by all applicable series of the Fund during the period. The actual percentage for each series may be higher or lower than the average depending on the level of trailing commissions and sales commissions paid for that series. The higher proportion of distribution-related payments is primarily attributable to sales commissions related to gross sales of the Fund.

Series PWF, Series PWF5 and Series PWF8 securities are offered through our Private Wealth Solutions to certain high net worth investors who are enrolled in a dealer-sponsored fee-for-service or wrap program, who are subject to an asset-based fee rather than commissions on each transaction and who invest at least \$100,000. Investors in Series PWF5 and Series PWF8 securities also want to receive a monthly cash flow of 5% or 8% per year, respectively.

Series PWFB and Series PWFB5 securities are offered through our Private Wealth Solutions to certain high net worth investors who invest a minimum of \$100,000. Investors are required to negotiate their advisor service fee, which cannot exceed 1.50%, with their financial advisor. Investors in Series PWFB5 securities also want to receive a monthly cash flow of 5% per year.

Series LW and Series LW5 securities are offered through our Preferred Pricing Program to certain high net worth investors who invest a minimum of \$100,000. Investors in Series LW5 securities also want to receive a monthly cash flow of 5% per year.

An investor in the Fund may choose among different purchase options that are available under each series. These purchase options are a sales charge purchase option and a no-load purchase option. The charges under the sales charge purchase option are negotiated by investors with their dealers. Not all purchase options are available under each series of the Fund, and the charges for each purchase option may vary among the different series.
